

Radio Promotions Order Terms and Conditions

I hereby confirm that I would like to place the aforementioned advertising on the National Health Review Radio Show and that I shall abide by all the terms and conditions as set by National Health Review. All programs during the duration of this Contract are to be as the sole and absolute discretion of National Health Review.

1. National Health Review reserves the right to:

- i. Refuse at its discretion to accept any advertising material that is the opinion of National Health Review as not consistent with guidelines or does not meet the technical linguistic or quality standards as determined by National Health Review.
- ii. Change the rates, terms and conditions;
- iii. Cancel, reschedule or replace any National Health Review program or advertising break;
- iv. Reschedule advertising booking as needed.

2. If an advertising booking is made in connection with a particular National Health Review Radio Program and that particular program is cancelled, the advertiser may have the booking rescheduled to a mutually acceptable time.

3. For booking cancellations on the part of the Advertiser, National Health Review will be entitled to payment in full as if the advertising had been broadcasted or the production had taken place in accordance with the original booking.

4. National Health Review gives no guarantee about the proximity of commercials advertising rival products.

5. National Health Review advertising time may not be resold or sublicensed.

6. The advertiser indemnifies National Health Review against any costs, expenses and damages which National Health Review may incur arising out of a commercial or sponsored program provided by the advertiser or the agency of the advertiser, the agency indemnifies National Health Review against any costs, expenses and damages which National Health Review may incur arising out of the broadcast.

7. All advertising bookings must be paid in full before the first date of the broadcast unless credit term has been previously agreed with National Health Review. National Health Review retains the right to refuse to extend credit to any Advertiser.

8. National Health Review will not be responsible for archiving any advertising material for more than one year after the first date of the broadcast.

9. National Health Review contract with media advertising agencies and media buying agencies in their own right and not as agents of their Advertisers.

10. Rates quoted are inclusive of all taxes and GST.

11. This agreement shall commence on signature date and is non cancellable.
